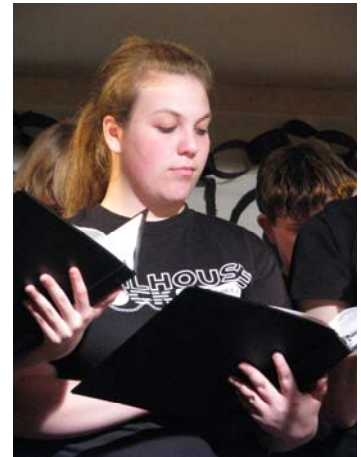
vacation bible school planning meeting
