## WHAT IS MUSIC CAMP 2011?

Music Camp 2011 is an opportunity for children to come together to explore, exercise and sharpen their artistic gifts, as they work together to learn, rehearse and perform the children's musical "Elijah, God's Faithful Prophet" Children will have the opportunity to sing, play instruments and move to music; as well as explore other artistic expressions of drama and the visual arts. Emphasis will be placed on celebrating the gifts God has given each child as we work together to produce a final performance for family, friends and the church congregation. Children can expect to work hard AND have LOTS of FUN! Prayer and scripture will be a part of each camp day. Campers will also participate in a missions project.

## WHO CAN COME?

The camp is open to any children who have completed first through sixth grade.

## WHEN IS MUSIC CAMP 2011?

Camp will be held Monday through Friday, July 11-15 from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m. each day. A full, dress rehearsal will be held Saturday, July 16 from 9:00 a.m. to noon. Performance will be Sunday, July 17 at 6 p.m.

**We ask that ALL campers make an effort to be present for the final performance. Every child will be given a role in the final performance and one absent child can make a difference.** If a child is absent for 12 or more hours during camp week, participation in Sunday evening's presentation will be minimal.



## HOW MUCH IS MUSIC CAMP 2011?

Camp is \$45 per camper for the week, which provides a camp t-shirt and snacks. Each additional sibling is \$25. A limited number of scholarships are available. **Registration and payment must be received by Sunday, June 26.**



## WHERE IS MUSIC CAMP 2011?

Music Camp 2011 will meet at Seventh & James Baptist Church, 602 James Avenue. We will begin and end each day in Harper Hall in the Melton Building. Throughout the day, campers, escorted by youth counselors, will use the various facilities at Seventh.

## WHO ARE THE LEADERS OF MUSIC CAMP 2011?

Camp will be lead by Paula Hoover, Coordinator of Children's Choirs at Seventh & James. Further camp leadership will be provided by Seventh & James staff, church members and youth counselors.

## WHAT ABOUT FOOD?

Campers need to bring a lunch and **drink** Monday through Friday to camp. A morning snack will be provided.

## WHAT DO I WEAR AND BRING?

You may wear any clothes (including shorts) that you don't mind getting messy. Remember, we will be active with movement and art-making. **Wear tennis shoes and socks, please.**
