She worked there until a few weeks before Alexandra Julie was born on November 3, 2004, and Carmen transitioned to working as a stay-home mom. The children were smaller than the football players, but certainly required more energy to work with! Samuel Eric was born November 2, 2006. Carmen is an active singer in the SMBC choir and also sings with a women's ensemble in the church. She has been in 6 of the last 7 Bach to Broadway productions at South Main, including playing the role of Nellie last year in *South Pacific*. She teaches ESL in the South Main International Learning Experience on Tuesdays and has been a member of the Houston Masterworks Chorus for eight years.

### Reverend Erin Blake Conaway

Erin grew up in Midland, Texas and earned a BA in English from Baylor University in 1997. He continued his education at George W. Truett Theological Seminary and graduated with a Master of Divinity in December, 2001. While attending Truett, he joined and attended Seventh and James. Erin is currently completing a Doctor of Ministry degree in the area of Pastoral Theology and Pastoral Care from Brite Divinity School, a division of Texas Christian University in Fort Worth, Texas. His doctoral project will focus on hope and the minister's role as an agent of hope with individuals as well as creating hopeful communities in congregations. He is on schedule to graduate in December of 2012.

Erin currently serves as Associate Pastor of South Main Baptist Church in Houston, Texas. His responsibilities include meeting pastoral care needs of the congregation through visitation in hospitals and nursing homes; grief, spiritual, pre-marital and marital counseling; giving oversight and leadership to the extensive mission efforts of the church including local mission efforts as well as international projects and trips; giving oversight and leadership to the outreach efforts of the church; trying to lead and stretch the church in its awareness and practice of spiritual disciplines; supply preaching and teaching. He has served in this position for nine years.

In addition to leading numerous mission trips and projects, Erin helped create a local program called "Manna," a service for homeless neighbors in the South Main area. Each Sunday morning, these neighbors are invited to share coffee, "manna bags" (non-perishable food and basic supplies), prayer requests, and a Scripture meditation with one another. This provides a sacred time of worship and fellowship with brothers and sisters who are often not welcomed any other place in the community. Erin also brings experience in Clinical Pastoral Education and Chaplaincy work at Hillcrest Baptist Medical Center in Waco, Texas where he was supervised by our own Seventh and James member, Ross Davis.

Erin and his wife Carmen were married in June of 2000 and are the proud parents of Alexandra and Samuel. In his free time, Erin loves to grill, watch movies with Carmen, take walks with the kids, fly fish, and snow ski.
